## President's Letter

Hello, Blue Ridge Members,

Have you ever fished **Mountain Heritage Trout Waters**? A couple of weeks ago went fishing on the North Toe in Spruce Pines, NC, and learned about the Mountain Heritage Trout Water program.

According to the website: "The Mountain Heritage Trout Waters program is a cooperative effort between the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission and local governments to encourage trout fishing as a heritage tourism activity in western North Carolina cities that are designated as a "Mountain Heritage Trout Water City." The cities are Newland, Spruce Pine, Waynesville, Bakersville, and Maggie Valley. See a map to the right.

Really nice maps and information are available at the website (Just Google *Mountain Heritage Trout Waters* to find it) and they even have arranged to let people borrow fishing gear at these locations.

The North Toe in Spruce Pines, as all five of the Mountain Heritage Trout Waters, runs right through the downtown area. I also went to Bakersville, and it's the same story... you can fish right in town! The waters are **stocked extra well**, in order to attract tourist anglers that could provide an **economic impact** to these small towns.

Does trout fishing really provide that much of an *economic benefit*? It seems so. According to the NC Wildlife Resources Commission study, "The Economic Impacts of Mountain Trout Fishing on North Carolina," the total impact of mountain trout fishing is estimated at \$174,000 per year. "Total economic impact of hatchery supported waters measured \$72.7 million; \$55.2 million for wild trout waters and \$46.5 million for delayed harvest. "

It's good to see that the mountain trout that Blue Ridge TU are actively protecting are providing a significant economic benefit.

I hope that all the members of Blue Ridge Trout Unlimited, and their families, have a **Merry Christmas!**

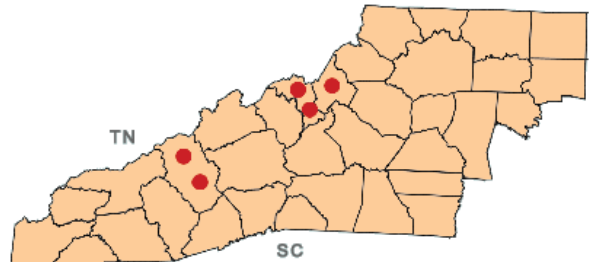
